FISHING REPORT FOR MARCH, 2012.

ESTUARY: Bream numbers increasing, most are undersize, but good fun for the kids with Cotton Tree the spot on the top of the tide. Serious anglers are drifting along the sand bank edges working bait for jacks, trevally and flathead around Goat Island. Poppers and plastics worth a try.

SURF: Rough conditions making the open beaches difficult to fish, but the protected headlands of Pt. Cartright and Pincushion returning chopper tailor and sea bream with frogmouth pillies the bait.

OFFSHORE: The Inner Gneerings working on the change of the tide for anglers willing to berley, with spanish mackerel and long tail tuna floated baits and if the bait sinks down to the shallow reef, look out for sweetlip, parrot and cod. The Barwon Banks returning southern fusiliers, snapper and pearlies.

GAMEFISHING: No serious reports of billfish with bait scattered, but, at this time of year the lead up to the moon is best. High speed lures worth a try for yellow fin and mackerel along The Fifty Meter Line.

FRESHWATER: Lake Baroon firing for bass and spangled perch, but don't use lead sinkers at this impoundment. Lake McDonald another local dam firing for bass on medium divers and live shrimps with the drop off along the weed bed opposite the boat ramp best. Lake Borumba always worth a visit with saratoga, bass and jew providing plenty of sport for anglers.
