### **FISHING REPORT FOR APRIL, 2014**

**ESTUARY:** Quality whiting working along the yabby banks around Goat and Channel Islands in the Maroochy River. Cod, trevally and jacks taking live baits around the Motorway Bridge pylons. Flathead picking up trolled lures from the banks near Muller Park, Bli Bli. Heaps of mud crabs, but a high percentage are female, undersize and illegal.

**SURF:** Pincushion returning bream on mullet fillet on the rising night tide and still a few tailor right on sunrise using slugs and pillies. Dart and whiting along both Maroochy and Mudjimba Beaches with pippies best.

**OFFSHORE:** A great week with action a plenty from Old Woman Island to Pt. Cartright and out around Murphy's Reef where spaniards and yellow-fin are snapping up trolled baits, lures, and well presented flies. Mixed reef fish taking squid and pillies from Murphy's to Wide Caloundra.

**FRESHWATER:** Golden perch and bass keeping most anglers happy in local dams, rivers and creeks. Many reports of alleged breaches of bag limits. If you care what happens to our fisheries please call Fisheries Qld if you witness any illegal activities.

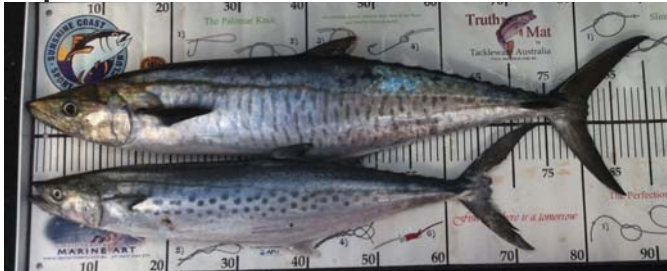
up with was that fish was a mackerel snapper hybrid and as such ineligible to be weighed in.
